



The Housing Trust Fund was established in 2018 by Ordinance No. 180719 to implement neighborhood revitalization, housing development, and preservation projects in accordance with the City's housing policy.

In 2021, Ordinance No. 210873 established the process funds would be allocated from the Housing Trust Fund.

- Created the Housing Trust Fund Board to review applications and recommend projects to Council through a bi-annual RFP process.
- Named priorities and requirements to guide the review and evaluation of projects.
