Purpose – Facilitate safety and security measures to assist patrons, residents and users to improve the safety conditions of the District; public area maintenance to improve the appearance and image of the CID; hire or contract for personnel to staff and provide services to the District, and marketing businesses and special events to increase patronage.

Specific Services – The CID has focused on Crime, Grime and Chime.

<u>Crime</u> – a security team has been deployed 14 hours a day, seven days a week to address quality of life/business interference issues, i.e., trespassing, shoplifting and other street crimes effecting businesses on the Avenue. In excess of 1,000 incident reports were written, a CID representative attend court for Repeat Nuisance Offenders and assisted shoppers with flat tires, lock out's and general safety/security issues

<u>Grime</u> – Five Urban Street Ambassadors picked up thousands of pounds of trash and debris from our primary business nodes. They greeted customers, gave directions and informed potential customers of shopping opportunities

<u>Chime</u> – The CID chimed in with marketing/branding ideas and designs, discussed with City officials and other partners how we could collaborate to accomplish the common goal of economic opportunities in the District.
